The CAVANAUGH Family

The Cavanaugh family appears in my 3rd generation as **Mary Ann Cavanaugh** was my G-Grandmother through my mother's Broughton lineage. My earliest known Cavanaugh was

John Cavanaugh (b.circa 1841)

John Cavanaugh was born in Hull about 1841 and was my GG-Grandfather. He became a fisherman and married **Eliza**. At this stage, I'm not absolutely certain of her identity or the date they married. However, in 1862 there was a marriage registered in Hull between a John Henry Cavanaugh and Ann Eliza Dean. This may have been my GG-Grandparents but I need to confirm this. John & Eliza had 4 children:-

From the above, we can see that John was a widower by 1891. This means that Eliza must have died at some time between 1881 & 1891 - probably when she was in her late

40s.

Mary Ann Cavanaugh (1871-1917)

Mary Ann Cavanaugh was my G-Grandmother. She was the oldest daughter of John Cavanaugh and Eliza. She married **Henry Herbert Broughton**, the son of Henry Broughton and Ann (nee Shay). They had 9 Children:-
