There is only one entry in the Lincolnshire IGI for a marriage between a George Hurdman and Ann. This is in 1766 in Willoughby (which is just 4 miles om Mumby, where son George was born in 1781).

Also, in Willoughby is a Richard Hurdman and his wife, Elizabeth. Her maiden name was also Hornby - probably a sister of Ann Hornby. Both George Hurdman and Richard Hurdman are listed in the IGI as being "of Grazier" (although this place does not appear to exist). He married Ann HORNBY #5218, 3 Aug 1766 in Willoughby, Lincolnshire.¹

In an 1853 Court Case (details at Hull Record Office), a George HURDMAN purchased a piece of land in Myton from William TODD for ø140. The land was bounded by the estate of John PEARSON on the south side of English St and belonged to Thomas ENGLISH and Edmund BRANSTON. George HURDMAN died on 17/8/1849 and the land was siezed back by the vendors. A will was proved at York on 6/3/1850.

Is this the same George HURD(S)MAN ? He married Mildred SQUIRES #314, 2 Nov 1801 in Haugh, Lincolnshire,¹ b. circa 1781,² d. circa 1856 in Hull, East Yorkshire.³
